Your Student's Classes at a Glance:

Reading/Language Arts: We will have our unit 6 test this week on Tuesday over pronouns, contractions, and homophones. Our next unit will be a writing unit where students will be learning how to compose their own personal narratives. We will also read the story *Chibi: A True Story from Japan*. As usual, we will have our reading and spelling test on Friday.

Math: Our chapter 16 math test over graphing was today. We will begin chapter 17 over measurement this week. If students have their own rulers (with inches and centimeters) from home they can bring them in to use. We also have a classroom set if they don't have their own.

Science: We will be completing our chapter this week over simple machines. Our test will be on Friday. Your child should use the study guide along with graded quizzes to help them study for this test. I realize that there is a lot of testing this week. Students will receive some time in class to complete their study guides and to study for their test. They also need to spend time at home studying as well. Please make sure they are not waiting until Thursday night to begin preparing for this test.

Social Studies: We will continue to learn about the history of important cities in the United States and how they have changed over time.
